



BIRD Celebrates World Environment Day 2019

BIRD & NBSC, Lucknow, celebrated "World Environment Day 2019" with UN theme "Beat Air Pollution" in the campus on 05 June 2019 between 6.00 am to 7.30 am. As part of the programme, a walkathon was organised that included bio diversity appreciation, photography competition, quiz and pledge to save the environment.

Smt. T S Raji Gain, Director, BIRD, while inaugurating the walkathon emphasised the importance of the celebration of the World Environment Day and shared different aspects of taking responsibility for minimising environmental pollution and conservation of biodiversity. Shri S V Sardesai, Principal, NBSC urged the participants to contribute positively through individual actions at personal level. During walkathon participants got opportunity to closely observe the biodiversity of the campus - different plant species like bamboo, neem, silk cotton trees, devil tree, teak, Ficus, banyan tree, Bixa spp, herbal garden, birds, bee keeping, green initiatives like solar power units, composting , water harvesting, waste water recycling etc.

A quiz on environmental issues was also organised during walkathon in which staff, faculty members, their family members & children, participants of the training programmes enthusiastically participated. Prizes were distributed to the winners of quiz.

A photo competition "Shoot and Win" capturing the nature within the campus was organised and out of 31 entries 5 entries were selected as winners and prizes were distributed.

In end of the program all the participants took a pledge to contribute to save our environment and conserve the bio-resources with their behavioural change.
